# Bible reading 1 Cor. 11:23-27

For I received from the Lord the teaching that I passed on to you: that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took a piece of bread, gave thanks to God, broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in memory of me." In the same way, after the supper he took the cup and said, "This cup is God's new covenant, sealed with my blood. Whenever you drink it, do so in memory of me."

This means that every time you eat this bread and drink from this cup you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. It follows that if one of you eats the Lord's bread or drinks from his cup in a way that dishonours him, you are guilty of sin against the Lord's body and blood.

### Sharing together in the bread and wine

Draw near with faith. Receive the body of our Lord Jesus Christ which he gave for you, and his blood which he shed for you. Eat and drink in remembrance that he died for you, and feed on him in your hearts, by faith with thanksgiving.

### Prayers are led by Jean:

### "Let us pray:

Heavenly Father thank you for all you have done for us over this past week and for bringing us safely here to be with our church family to worship you today.

We confess our need for you today. We need your healing and your grace and sometimes we need to be reminded that you work on our behalf and for all those you love, constantly, powerfully and completely

Forgive us for trying to fix our problems on our own, for running in all different directions to find help when the true help and healing can only be found in you. Forgive us for forgetting how much we need you above everyone and everything.

You see where no else is able to fully see or understand, you know our pains, our worries, our burdens. Thank you that you are able to do far more than we can ever imagine.

We watch with grief and horror as the violence in Israel and Gaza intensifies, following the dreadful terrorist attack on Israel by Hamas. We condemn the acts of violence, particularly those that are targeting innocent civilians - men, women and children who are killed and held

hostage while simply trying to live. We ask that leaders seek a way forward that ends the vicious cycles of violence and finds a way to build peace among peoples and nations, in which everyone can flourish and prosper. We remember that all people are created in your image, and therefore deserve to be treated with respect and dignity, to live lives free of fear and violence.

We pray too for an end to violence in this country, particularly for an end to anti-Semitic violence; our Jewish brothers and sisters deserve to live lives free from fear. No school should have to close because of security threats; places of worship should not need security guards to keep worshippers safe. Prejudice has no place in our society, whether anti-Jewish or anti-Muslim, and the war between Hamas and Israel must not be used to demonise whole communities and destabilise the peace that we so value in our cities and towns.

Father we continue to remember Ukraine, we pray that your peace will reign; that justice and mercy will bring an end to war and terror and that all soldiers from each side can go home and live their lives in peace and harmony respecting their neighbours. Soften Putin's heart Lord, help him to see the wrong he is doing to so many thousands of people.

We ask for your hand on all areas around the world that are troubled, Be with the women of Afghanistan, bit by bit they are having all freedoms taken away and are unable to contribute to their communities because of the restrictions that the Taliban place on them. Help them to stay strong.

We pray for your church throughout the world we remember those Christians in countries where their beliefs make them vulnerable and in danger. Uphold and strengthen all who are persecuted and tortured for their faith.

Heavenly Father, we pray for those who represent us in government and in our own home town. May they be men and women of integrity, guided by a desire for public service and a love of the truth. We ask that they also be just and compassionate.

Father, we bring to you our church family. We all have aches and pains - some more than others! But Father you know those who are really struggling. Please be with them all, may the Doctors do their best to find the best treatment to help them get well, and for those awaiting operations help to keep them well so there is no delay. For those who have had falls and trips be with them, help them to heal and allow them to regain their confidence and give them patience as they recover.

Faithful God as we go out into the world shining with your light and your truth help us to reflect your love in our families, our church and our community; so that the world can witness that we are followers of You and through that witness draw others into your loving care.

We ask all this in the precious name of your Son. Amen"

### Bible readings, Jane, Jeremiah 23: 16-24
