1	"Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters – one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah."	
2	"You take him and crucify him. As for me, I find no basis for a charge against him."	
3	"About noon as I came near Damascus, suddenly a bright light from heaven flashed around me."	
4	"Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no-one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him."	
5	"Do you think that in such a short time you can persuade me to be a Christian?"	
6	"Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!"	
7	"Go and make a careful search for the child. As soon as you find him, report to me, so that I too may go and worship him."	
8	"What are you willing to give me if I hand him over to you?"	
9	"If you consider me a believer in the Lord, come and stay at my house."	
10	"Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it."	
11	"Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"	
12	"Are you willing to go up to Jerusalem and stand trial before me there on these charges?"	
13	"You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit!"	
14	"I baptise you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie."	
15	"Look Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."	
16	"Four days ago I was in my house praying at this hour, at three in the afternoon. Suddenly a man in shining clothes stood before me....."	
17	"Are you the only one living in Jerusalem who doesn't know the things that have happened there in these days?"	
18	"Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have put him, and I will get him."	
19	"Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear! But why am I so favoured, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"	
20	"Here are my mother and my brothers! Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother."
