

Do you know who in the **Old Testament said each of the following phrases?
(The references are taken from the NIV version of the Bible.)**

1	“God has brought me laughter, and everyone who hears about this will laugh with me.”	
2	“Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.'”	
3	“No wise man, enchanter, magician or diviner can explain to the king the mystery he has asked about, but there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries.”	
4	“Up! Leave my people, you and the Israelites! Go, worship the Lord as you have requested. Take your flocks and herds as you have said, and go.”	
5	“The Lord forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the Lord's anointed, or lift my hand against him; for he is the anointed of the Lord.”	
6	“Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay.”	
7	“My son, bring me some of your game to eat, so that I may give you my blessing.”	
8	“Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus better than any of the waters of Israel? Couldn't I wash in them and be cleansed?”	
9	“Go to the hills so the pursuers will not find you. Hide yourselves there three days until they return, and then go on your way.”	
10	“In my distress I called to the Lord, and he answered me. From the depths of the grave I called for help, and you listened to my cry.”	
11	“So I told them, 'Whoever has any gold jewellery, take it off.' Then they gave me the gold, and I threw it into the fire, and out came this calf!”	
12	“As the Lord, the God of Israel, lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word.”	
13	“.....I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him. So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he shall be given over to the Lord.”	
14	“Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed, and the fourth looks like a son of the gods.”	
15	“I am the daughter of Bethuel, the son Milcah bore to Nahor.”.....”We have plenty of straw and fodder, as well as room for you to spend the night.”	
16	“Take this baby and nurse him for me, and I will pay you.”	
17	“Give the living baby to the first woman. Do not kill him; she is his mother.”	
18	“I too had a dream. On my head were three baskets of bread. In the top basket were all kinds of baked goods for Pharaoh.....”	
19	“O Lord, I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue.”	
20	“You are not able to go out against this Philistine and fight him; you are only a boy, and he has been a fighting man from his youth.”
